SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve a FFY 2022 Department of Homeland Security

(DHS) grant passed through the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) from the State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management (NDEM) awarding [\$6,288.08, no County match required], for a Continuity of Operations and Continuity of Government project; including funds to be used for Planning and Training events. Grant term is retroactive from September 1, 2022, through January 30, 2025. If approved, authorize the County Manager or his designee to sign the grant award documents when received; and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the necessary budget amendments. (All Commission Districts.) FOR POSSIBLE ACTION

SUMMARY

This item recommends that the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners (the board) approve a FFY 2022 DHS grant passed through the SHSP from the NDEM for a Continuity of Operations and Continuity of Government project awarding [\$6,288,08, no County match required]; including funds to be used for travel purchases for planning and training events. Grant term is retroactive to September 1, 2022, through January 30, 2025.

The State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant is used to fund sustainment efforts in Northern and Southern Nevada regarding Continuity of Operations Plans (COOP). The State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management has provided this grant award to Washoe County for more than 13 years.

This grant is retroactive due to de-obligated FFY 2022 SHSP grants funds becoming available.

The Board has approved this grant for the past 13+ years.

BACKGROUND

This FFY 2022 Department of Homeland Security (DHS) State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant is an enhancement of the Continuity of Operations/Continuity of Government (COOP/COG) initiative that begun in FFY 2011.

These plans are directed by Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD)-20 and Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 239c. These plans are also a Government Accounting Office (GAO) best practice, and a component of the Emergency Management Accreditation Program (EMAP) as well as the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) - 1600.

The COOP/COG project supports the Nevada Commission on Homeland Security priorities and goals. These plans are directly aligned with the goals of critical infrastructure protection, communications, and public safety. The COOP/COG project is a key component of the National Incident Management System (NIMS) compliance.

This project is an extension of the actions to build and sustain local government preparedness. Project deliverables include sustainment of existing plans, training, and workshops in the interest of providing safe, secure, and healthy communities.

This grant requires no match.

GRANT AWARD SUMMARY

Project/Program Name: FFY 2022 SHSP Continuity of Operations

Scope of the Project: The benefit of this funding is to sustain and provide planning and training to agencies to continue their essential functions and mitigate disruptions to operations across a broad spectrum of hazards and emergencies.

Benefit to Washoe County Residents: The benefit of this funding is for emergency preparedness for the protection of life and property in the region from hazards and disasters.
