## **SUMMARY**

Washoe County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) is requested to accept a FFY22 Department of Homeland Security (DHS) grant passed through the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) for a Animal Shelter Trailer Project awarding [\$123,948.00, no County match required]. Grant term is retroactive to September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2024.

The grant will provide funding for the enhancement of animal sheltering efforts in Northern Nevada.

The State issued this award retroactive from the date they received DHS funding.

This FFY22 Department of Homeland Security (DHS) State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant is an enhancement of the region's ability to shelter animals in close proximity to their owners. This was a gap identified during the Caldor Fire response.

**Scope of the Project:** The benefit of this funding is to increase shelter capacity for pets and facilitate close proximity sheltering with their owners across a broad spectrum of hazards and emergencies.
