Playground Improvement Project, PWP-WA-2024-108, [staff

recommends Garden Shop Nursery Landscaping Division, Inc., in the amount of \$570,345.83]. The Project is located at 13401 Rim Rock Drive, Reno, Nevada, and the scope of work is to replace existing

playground equipment. (Commission District 2.)

SUMMARY

The Virginia Foothills Park Playground Improvement Project will consist of demolition of existing play equipment and surface materials, installation of drainage components, subgrade, and aggregate base, furnish and install benches, new play equipment, rubber safety surface, and engineered wood fiber safety mulch.

Sealed bids for the Virginia Foothills Park Playground Improvement Project were opened via eBuilder on February 22, 2024.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On May 16, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) adopted the Washoe County Final budget for Fiscal Year 2024 as well as adopting the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for Fiscal Years 2024-2028.

BACKGROUND

Virginia Foothills Park is located at 13401 Rim Rock Drive (Commission District 2 and Park District 3B). The 12-acre neighborhood park features tennis courts, ball fields, shaded group picnic area, playground, flex field, horseshoe pits, restroom, and walking paths. The park and playground improvements were originally installed in 1980.

FISCAL IMPACT

Sufficient budget authority for this agreement exists in the FY24 Budget in the Capital Improvements Fund (402), Virginia Foothills Park Playground Replacement project (PW920865).

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners award a bid and approve the Agreement to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the Virginia Foothills Park Playground Improvement Project, PWP-WA-2024-108, [staff recommends Garden Shop Nursery Landscaping Division, Inc., in the amount of \$570,345.83]. The Project is located at 13401 Rim Rock Drive, Reno, Nevada, and the scope of work is to replace existing playground equipment.
