SUBJECT: Recommendation to accept one-time appreciation gift donations [estimated value of \$17,683.70] from private citizens to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office. (All Commission Districts.)

SUMMARY

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has received various in-kind gift donations of food in the total estimated amount of \$17,683.70 from private citizens. These donations were given in appreciation of the services the employees of the Sheriff's Office provide to Washoe County citizens for use within the Sheriff's Office.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, Secure and Healthy Communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On January 26, 2021, the Board accepted item 5.B., one-time appreciation gift donations [estimated value of \$16,983.45] from private citizens to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

On November 17, 2020, the Board accepted item 9.C., one-time appreciation gift donations [estimated value of \$1,250.00] from private citizens to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

On September 15, 2020, the Board accepted item 5.B., one-time appreciation gift donations [estimated value of \$1,670.00] from private citizens to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

On July 21, 2020, the Board accepted item 8.B., one-time appreciation gift donations [estimated value of \$2,935.00, including a \$25.00 cash donation] from private citizens to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

On June 16, 2020, the Board accepted item 6.B.2., one-time appreciation gift donations [estimated value of \$1,855.00] from private citizens to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

On May 19, 2020, the Board accepted item 9.C., one-time appreciation gift donations [estimated value of \$6,397.00] from private citizens to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

On January 21, 2020, the Board accepted item 8.A., a one-time appreciation gift donation of 300 tri-tip individual meals [estimated value of \$6,000.00] from a private citizen to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

On August 27, 2019, the Board accepted item 6.B., an in-kind donation of ten (10) bags of coffee [valued at \$139.90] from Black Rifle Coffee to be used by the employees of the Sheriff's Office.

On February 19, 2019, the Board accepted item 8.C.2., one-time in-kind appreciation gift and other donations [estimated value of \$222.20] from private citizens to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

On January 15, 2019, the Board accepted item 8.C.1., a one-time in-kind appreciation gift donation of 300 tri-tip individual meals [estimated value of \$6,000.00] from a private citizen to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

On November 13, 2018, the Board accepted item 10.B., a one-time in-kind appreciation gift donation of two dozen doughnuts [estimated value of \$25.00] from a private citizen to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office and the Regional Aviation Enforcement (RAVEN) Unit.

On October 16, 2018, the Board accepted item 8.E.1., one-time in-kind appreciation gift donations [estimated value of \$380.00] from private citizens to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.
