BACKGROUND

This subaward supports the Immunization program mission to public health by reducing vaccine-preventable disease through immunization, with an emphasis on collaboration and cooperation with community partners.

The District Board of Health is scheduled to accept this subaward at its May 27, 2021 meeting.

GRANT AWARD SUMMARY

Project/Program Name: Immunizations COVID Compliance Grant

Scope of the Project: This Subaward provides funding to plan and implement COVID-19 vaccination services such as compliance and vaccination distribution.

Benefit to Washoe County Residents: Provides outreach vaccination clinics such as PODs and strike team clinics that reach target populations.

On-Going Program Support: This is one-time funding to support planning and implementing COVID-19 vaccination services.

Award Amount: \$4,321,402.97 (\$392,854.81 indirect) **Grant Period:** July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022
