SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve, pursuant to NRS 244.1505, Commission

District Special Fund disbursement in the amount of [\$15,000.00] for Fiscal Year 2022-2023; District 5 Commissioner Jeanne Herman recommends a [\$15,000.00] grant to Red Rock Volunteer Fire Department -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to support costs associated with the purchase, installation and support of a generator at the Red Rock Volunteer Fire Department; approve Resolution necessary for same; and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the necessary disbursement of funds.

SUMMARY

This item requests the Board to approve resolutions and disburse district funds in the total amount of [\$15,000.00] for Commission District 5.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On December 20, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners directed [\$1,000.00] to the Commissioner Support Team to support the Washoe County Academy Leadership Academy class project.

On January 17, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners directed [\$20,000.00] to Safe Embrace to support the organization's efforts to provide compassionate and traumainformed services to individuals suffering from domestic abuse, sexual violence or human trafficking; [\$10,000.00] to the Vya Conservation District for the purpose of supporting natural resource conservation and ensuring sustainable use of northwestern Nevada's natural resources; [\$10,000.00] to the Washoe-Storey Conservation District -- a government entity -- for the purpose of fostering environmental stewardship and management of natural resources; [\$10,000.00] to the Reno Air Racing Association to support the Reno Air Races event and for its Pilot Training Scholarships and STEM initiatives; [\$5,000.00] to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada to support the organization's efforts to provide food for families in need throughout the region; [\$2,500.00] to Our Story, Inc. for the purpose of benefiting the Northern Nevada African American Firefighter Museum; [\$2,500.00] to the Adopt A Vet Dental Program to provide free critical and life-saving dental care to impoverished veterans in Nevada; [\$2,500.00] to the Washoe County Human Services Agency for the purpose of supporting the Men's CrossRoads program, a supportive living community providing drug- and alcohol-free housing and programming for men transitioning out of homelessness; [\$2,500.00] to the Veterans Upward Bound Program at Truckee Meadows Community College for the purpose of supporting educational and career success for U.S. military veterans; [\$2,500.00] to The Salvation Army to support its human trafficking survivor program; [\$2,500.00] to the Veterans Guest House to support its mission of providing U.S. military service veterans and their families with caring support during times of medical need; and [\$2,000.00] to the Center for Healthy Aging for the purpose of supporting its intergenerational community garden site and indigenous food program, Teach Me To Grow Healthy.

On March 28, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners directed [\$2,000.00] to The Sons and Daughters of Erin to support the program's efforts to promote Irish heritage and culture.

BACKGROUND

Modification of guidelines and adoption of resolution for County Commission District Special Funding on February 10, 2015 created Commission District Special Funds for each Commission District. On May 17, 2022 the Board of County Commissioners approved the 2022-2023 fiscal year budget with special district funds allocated per Commission District in the amount of \$100,000.00. The monies appropriated are to support needs for all Washoe County residents.

Funds appropriated through the Commission District Special Funds must provide substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County. The recipient must be a non-profit organization, created for religious, charitable, or educational purposes, or a government entity. Funds shall not provide any personal or private benefit for the Commissioners,

directly or indirectly benefit any campaign efforts by a commissioner, violate Ethics in Government law, or be used to purchase tickets to special events.

Commissioner Herman has elected to support the following organization in fiscal year 2022-2023:

• [\$15,000.00] grant to Red Rock Volunteer Fire Department -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to support costs associated with the purchase, installation and support of a generator at the Red Rock Volunteer Fire Department. The Red Rock Volunteer Fire Department provides first responder services to residents in the Red Rock area of Washoe County.

FISCAL IMPACT

Sufficient FY23 budget authority exists within the Cost Center District 5 Constituents (C100105) and account Payments to other Agencies (710400). This action requests approval and distribution of a [total of \$15,000.00] to Red Rock Volunteer Fire Department.

Expense Disbursements are required as follows:

• Red Rock Volunteer Fire Department: \$15,000.00

Should the Board agree with staff's recommendation, a possible motion would be: "Move to approve the recommendation to approve, pursuant to NRS 244.1505, Commission District Special Fund disbursement in the amount of [\$15,000.00] for Fiscal Year 2022-2023; District 3 Commissioner Mariluz Garcia recommends a [\$5,000.00] grant to Soulful Seeds -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to support costs associated with the construction of a community garden at Our Place; and a [\$5,000.00] grant to Shades of Queening -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to support their upcoming community workshops that will promote mental health awareness and inter-generational dialogue; and a [\$5,000.00] grant to Upstate Nevada -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to support the adaptive fitness program designed for adults and children with physical or cognitive disabilities and their family members; approve Resolutions necessary for same; and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the necessary disbursements of funds."
