(HIDTA) Management funding from the Office of National Drug Control

Policy (ONDCP) as administered through Las Vegas Metro Police

Department [amount not to exceed \$89,670.00] no County match required]

to be used for the installation of Automatic License Plate Readers retroactive period of March 7, 2024 to June 30, 2024, and direct Comptroller's Office to make the necessary budget amendments. (All

SUMMARY

This funding is received from the United States Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) and awarded to the Las Vegas Metro Police Department and made available to agencies across the State. These funds will be used to fund the installation and equipment lease cost for Automatic License Plate Readers in several areas in Northern Nevada. The mission of the HIDTA program is to disrupt the market for illegal drugs in the United States by assisting federal, state, and local law enforcement entities participating in the HIDTA program to dismantle and disrupt drug trafficking organizations.

Las Vegas Metro Police Department is the designated fiscal agent and prepares the reimbursement claims for task force operations for the federal funding awarded to the State of Nevada to be utilized by the Northern Nevada Interdiction Task Force of which the Washoe County Sheriff's Office is an integral team member.

<u>Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item:</u> Efficient Delivery of Regional Services and Supports a Thriving Community.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On September 8, 2020, the Board accepted item # 5.G2., 2020 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) License Plate Readers (LPR) funding [amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, no County match required] and Sole Source Purchase of 2 LPR trailers to be

utilized by the HIDTA Task force as administered through Las Vegas Metro Police Department, for the retroactive grant period of August 3, 2020 – December 31, 2021

The Board has been approving funding for the HIDTA Northern Nevada Interdiction Task Force since 2008.

BACKGROUND

The mission of the HIDTA program is to disrupt the market for illegal drugs in the United States by assisting federal, state, and local law enforcement entities participating in the HIDTA program in the dismantling and disruption of drug trafficking organizations. Washoe County became part of Northern Nevada HIDTA Task Force in the fall of 2006, when the Board formally approved the Washoe County Sheriff's participation by way of interlocal agreement on November 13, 2006.

Reason for retroactive submittal: Item was submitted to the first available BCC meeting once documents were received and processed.
