SUMMARY

It is recommend that the Washoe Board of County Commissioners accept the Nevada Cares Campus Charitable Fund Grant from the Community Foundation of Northern Nevada to support Nevada Cares Campus Capital Improvement Project in the amount of [\$1,669,180.00, no match] retroactively effective November 23, 2022-June 30, 2024. Authorize the County Manager to sign award document, and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the necessary budget amendments.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Vulnerable Populations

PREVIOUS ACTION

On May 10, 2022, the Washoe County Board of Commissioners approved Clark/Sullivan Constructors Inc., doing business as, Clark Sullivan Construction as the Construction Manager-At-Risk (CMAR) and approved Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) Agreement 1 for Phase 2 to construct restroom, shower & laundry facilities, concrete floor sealing in the sprung structure and provide and install personal living cubicles fo rhte NV Cares Improvement Project, located at 1800 Threlkel Street [in the amount of \$12,148,912] and commencing May 10, 2022.

On December 14, 2021, the Washoe County Board of Commissioners approved allocation of American Rescue Plan Act funds through the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund in a total amount of \$40,201,764.00, to support 23 projects, including funding for the Cares Campus – Washoe County Cares Campus Capital.

At a concurrent meeting held August 30, 2021, Amendment No. 2, and Extension of Interlocal Cooperative Agreement for Shelter Operation and Other Homeless Services Among the City of Reno, Washoe County and the City of Sparks was approved revising the roles and responsibilities of the entities, including transferring the administrative and financial responsibility for the operation of homeless shelters from City of Reno to Washoe County.

On January 13, 2021, direction was provided by the BCC to include pursuing an expanded role in addressing the regional issue of homelessness in the Strategic Plan.

On November 18, 2020 the parties entered into an Interlocal Cooperative Agreement for Shelter Operation and Other Homeless Services Among The City of Reno, Washoe County and The City of Sparks which established duties, roles and responsibilities of the parties in regard to the provision of services to the homeless in the Cities and County, including agreeing to acquire and cost share three parcels on East 4th Street for the purpose of expanding shelter capacity in the region to assist people experiencing homelessness.

BACKGROUND

The Nevada Cares Campus Charitable Fund at the Community Foundation of Northern Nevada is a public-private partnership fundraising effort. The fundraising committee members include: Par Tolles (Chairman) – Tolles Development, Ron Codd (Co-Chair) – Montreax Cares Committee, Eaton Dunkelberger – Community Foundation of Northern Nevada, Allison Gorelick – Gorelick Real Estate Advisors, Comissioner Alexis Hill – Washoe County, Mike Kazmierski – EDAWN, Councilwoman Charlene Bybee – City of Sparks, Chad Martinson – ACOVA Integrated Health, Neoma Jardon – Downtown Reno Partnership, Kate Thomas – Washoe County, Doug Thornley – City of Reno.

The Nevada Cares Campus Charitable Fund was created to support the Nevada Cares Campus centralization of shelter and wrap-around services that will simplify the process of reducing homelessness, putting people on the pathway to recovery, health, and financial stability. It will eliminate many of the physical and administrative barriers to assistance that our vulnerable neighbors currently face and improve the quality of life for everyone in our region.

The award is being approved retroactively due to the administrative lag between the award letter being issued and approval required by the Board of County Commissioners.
