SUMMARY

Washoe County Regional Animal Services has been the recipient of donations totaling \$12,989.88 donated for the humane care and treatment of sick and/or injured, stray, abandoned, or at-risk animals.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: <u>Safe, Secure and Healthy</u> Communities

PREVIOUS ACTION

On a quarterly basis, the Board of County Commissioners has accepted similar prior donations on behalf of Washoe County Regional Animal Services.

On May 26, 2020, the Board accepted donations to Washoe County Regional Animal Services in the amount of \$12,283.72 for the period of January 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020, to be used for the humane care and treatment of sick and/or injured, stray, abandoned, or at-risk animals.

On February 18, 2020, the Board accepted donations to Washoe County Regional Animal Services in the amount of \$10,621.84 for the period of October 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019, to be used for the humane care and treatment of sick and/or injured, stray, abandoned, or at-risk animals.

On November 19, 2019, the Board accepted donations to Washoe County Regional Animal Services in the amount of \$8, 342.00 for the period of July 1, 2019 to September

30, 2019, to be used for the humane care and treatment of sick and/or injured, stray, abandoned, or at-risk animals.

BACKGROUND

For the period of April 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020, Washoe County Regional Animal Services was the recipient of donations totaling \$12,989.88. (Reference attached list).

Donations are generally used to encourage responsible pet ownership, seek treatment of sick animals, injured animals or at-risk animals, and to promote humane treatment of animals.

FISCAL IMPACT

Upon receipt, donations are deposited into a special Internal Order for donations, IN 20319-484000 (Injured Animal Fund-Donations). Should the Board accept the donations; the Animal Services FY21 Adopted Budget will be increased in the following accounts:

IN20319-484000 Injured Animal Fund-Donations \$12,989.88 IN20319-710500 Injured Animal Fund-Other Expense \$12,989.88

RECOMMENDATION
