SUMMARY

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) accept a donation of a 2006 Advanced Containment Systems mobile decontamination shower trailer valued at [\$104,000.00] from The Washoe County Honorary Deputies Association to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office Special Operations Division.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Economic Impacts: Meet the needs of our growing community.

BACKGROUND

As we move into the post pandemic era, we have learned that there are several different scenarios that may occur while policing where law enforcement may need a mobile self-contained decontamination shower trailer.

The Washoe County Honorary Deputies Association has graciously donated a 2006 Advanced Containment Systems mobile decontamination shower trailer valued at [\$104,000.00].

This trailer can be deployed to prolonged scenes in remote areas such as a Search and Rescue mission north of Gerlach and special events like Burning Man. This trailer can be used as a mobile shower bank as well as its self-contained decontamination for civil unrest (gas and chemical irritant exposure) or potential exposures to Covid and or fentanyl.
